Alternate Piccolo Fingering Chart

Professional piccolo players use alternate fingerings on a regular basis. You should experiment with your instrument to find the fingerings that work best for you that will enable you to play in tune and with a good tone. Keep in mind that the fingerings listed in this guide might not work on all piccolos, and that any alternate fingering that sounds inferior is not an acceptable fingering! I also firmly believe that alternate fingerings are NOT to be used to make up for poor technique. That being said, alternate fingerings can do a lot to enhance the advanced piccolo player's performance.

The X on piccolo means to close the end of the tube using your right hand pinky.
